I PURPOSE

This work instruction is to provide quality assurance requirements information to be part of all Purchase orders generated by QED personnel. A copy of this WI shall be posted on the QED, Inc. website. QED purchase orders will reference appropriate QAP's for all goods and services that are to be used in QED manufactured products. It will be the suppliers responsibility to access the applicable referenced QAPs.

II SCOPE

This work instruction establishes definitions for each code printed or recorded on QED purchase order form (see table 1)

III Product category

<u>A</u>

Products or services that conform to purchasing documents that are verified at QED by reviewing the certification supplied by the supplier (i.e. Calibration, Plating, Heat-treat, Nondestructive testing, Military or other non-QED/inc. specifications, etc.)

В

Product or services that conform to purchasing documents requiring verification upon receipt at QED (i.e. Sub assemblies, parts made for QED based on QED/inc. Drawings and/or QED/inc. specifications, etc.)

<u>C</u>

Products or services that are not subject to quality review. Items in this category should never be used in a shippable product.

D

Customer supplied raw material or components.

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Code	Description		
QAP1	Government source inspection is required prior to shipping by the supplier. The supplier shall notify government representative to plan source inspection		
QAP2	Chemical and Physical analysis shall be supplied with the shipment. The		
	supplier shall provide, as a minimum, a copy of the test report and certification		
	of chemical analyses of material.		
QAP3	The supplier shall maintain a quality system that is acceptable to QED. (i.e.		
	AS9100, ISO9001, MIL-I-45208, et cetera)		
QAP4	The supplier shall perform and provide a copy of a 1 st article inspection to the		
	requirements noted on the purchase order.		
QAP5	The supplier shall provide a Certificate of Compliance. (C of C) Each shipment		
	shall be accompanied by one signed and legible copy of a Certification of		
	Compliance identifying the process and/or material, the purchase order		
	number, and the specification to which they conform. Material will not be		
OADC	processed until a certificate is received.		
QAP6	The supplier shall maintain raw material records. These shall be maintained		
	on file by supplier and identify lot number, material type, specification, heat		
QAP7	number, et cetera. (as appropriate to the products supplied). The supplier shall establish handling procedures to protect threads, machined		
QAP1	surfaces, sealing surfaces and other critical attributes during manufacture,		
	processing and shipment of QED products.		
QAP8	The supplier shall inspect and verify key characteristics. (These features shall		
Q/11 0	be identified on the purchase order and designated with "KEY" symbol).		
	Statistical process control and capability measures are required to be		
	furnished by the supplier of such products.		
QAP9	The supplier shall maintain a Software control Plan in accordance with or		
	compliant to the QED Quality System Manual.		
QAP10	The supplier shall report all process changes that affect QED product to QED		
	for approval prior to implementation (i.e. new equipment, process changes,		
	etc.)		
QAP11	Stripping and re-plating are not permitted without prior approval of QED.		
QAP12	The supplier shall provide a copy of the MSDS with the shipment of the goods.		
QAP13	The supplier shall provide information on the shelf life of the products with the		
0.15//	shipment of the goods.		
QAP14	No welding, brazing or other similar processes shall be used to rework		
0.4545	discrepant parts without prior approval by QED.		
QAP15	Specialty metals must meet the requirements of DFARS 225.872-1 and		
04040	DFARS 252.225-7014.		
QAP 16	The supplier shall maintain a documented electronic counterfeit avoidance		
QAP 17	plan in accordance with AS5553 and AS6174. The supplier shall maintain a documented FOD prevention program. The		
QAF II	program shall be compliant with National Aerospace Standard NAS-412:		
	Foreign Object Damage/Foreign Object Debris (FOD) Prevention.		
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
